As a result of the inspection conducted on December 3, 1980, and in accordance with the Interim Enforcement Policy, 45 FR 66754 (October 7, 1980), the following violation was identified:

10 CFR 32.20 requires that you submit an annual summary report to the Commission within thirty days following the year ending June 30 stating the total quantity of each isotope transferred under your license issued pursuant to 10 CFR 32.18. If no transfers of byproduct material have been made pursuant to §32.18 during the reporting period, the report shall so indicate.

Contrary to this requirement, as of the day of the inspection, December 3, 1980, you failed to submit the annual reports to the Commission for the period ending on June 30, 1980.

This is a Severity Level VI Violation (Supplement VII).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, RIA Products, Inc., is hereby required to submit to this office within twenty-five days of the date of this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Under the authority of Section 182 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, this response shall be submitted under oath or affirmation.
