Gentlemen:

This letter is in response to the Commission's recent safety inspection findings on March 12, 1981, of activities authorized by NRC By-product Material License No. 42-09073-02. The following are the actions being taken to correct the three items of noncompliance found and to prevent their recurrence:

- a. A letter was mailed on April 1, 1981, to the NRC Director of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards requesting that a general license be issued our Company for shipment in containers as outlined in 10 CFE, Pact 71.12.
 - b. Whenever new or additing equipment is required in the future, a revision or amendment will be submitted to the NRC Director of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards.
- a. On March 12, 1981, a request was made to several source manufacturers to obtain copies of certificates of compliance for transport of Type B quantities of Iridium-192 which were applicable to our program.
 - b. Copies of the certificates of compliance arrived on March 18, 1981, and are now being maintained on file.
 - c. Whenever new or additional equipment is required, certificates of compliance will be requested and placed on file.
- a. Also on March 18, 1981, copies of certificates of competent authority for transport of special form radiography sources were obtained which were applicable to our program.
 - b. These certificates are now being maintained on file.
 - c. Whenever new or additional equipment is required certificates will be requested and placed on file.

4. Full compliance of items 2 and 3 above are now in effect. Item 1 will be in full compliance when the NRC issues our Company a general license, which is expected by June 1, 1981.

We believe that these actions will be sufficient to remedy the specific areas of non-compliance. If there are further questions concerning these matters, please feel free to contact us.
