Gentlemen:

In accordance with your application dated February 28, 1979, as supplemented April 4 and 19, 1979, and pursuant to Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 70, Special Nuclear Materials License No. SNM-1097 is hereby amended to include your emergency plan. Accordingly, effective July 30, 1979, Condition 13 of SNM-1097 is amended to read as follows:

Condition 13. Notwithstanding Section 6.2.8 of Appendix A of the licensee's application, the licensee shall maintain a capability for handling emergencies in accordance with the emergency plan transmitted by the letter of February 28, 1978, and supplemented April 4 and 19, 1979. The licensee shall make no changes to the plan which decrease its effectiveness without the prior approval of the Commission.

Changes made to the emergency plan without prior Commission approval shall be submitted within thirty days, for information purposes, to the Region II Office of Inspection and Enforcement and the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards.

Certain wording in the plan, patterned after the wording in Regulatory Guide 3.42, such as, "The plan provides for . . ." in paragraph 8.1.2, will be interpreted as introducing requirements under the plan. This interpretation of the intent of the wording was discussed and agreed to by Mr. Kaplan on March 1, 1979.

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
