Gentlemen:

We have received your letters of March 22 and 23, 1979, concerning lagoon waste fixation and disposal, and agree that the proposed on-site activities are authorized by your license. Furthermore, this proposed action for permanent disposal of the accumulated on-site calcium fluoride waste accords with the recommendation on page 3-17 of the Environmental Impact Appraisal issued by the NRC in connection with the renewal of your license. On the basis of the information provided, we expect you to schedule the waste disposal operation so that construction of additional process waste lagoons will be unnecessary and the overall effect on the environment will thus be beneficial.

We will file the description of the waste disposal operation transmitted by the letters of March 22 and 23, with the safety demonstration for license SNM-1107.
