


assurance the plant operation can be resumed without undue risk to the health and safety of the public. The Staff presented its analysis and conclusions to the Commission on May 30, 1979, and received Commission approval prior to issuance of the license amendment and Safety Evaluation, as indicated by the attached Memorandum of the Secretary. (The Commission's approval is recorded on page 32 of the transcript of the May 30, 1979 meeting.)


