By note dated December 7, 1978, you forwarded a copy of a letter from Mrs. P. M. Allen to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, dated November 1, 1978. Mrs. Allen's letter had requested the Commission to revoke the Virginia Electric and Power Company's licenses to operate North Anna Units No. 1 and 2.

By letter dated December 27, 1978, I responded to your note providing information on NRC actions as of that date, and providing further information.

The ir stigation into the merits of Mrs. Allen's request has been completed and a sport has been prepared. Based on the content of that report, a decision has been reached that the request should be denied.
