This revision adds additional specific qualification requirements in section C.9 (Audits) which were not in Revision 0 The requirements for the qualifications of auditors are already adequately described in issued or draft Regulatory Guides such as R.G. 1.144 and Task 810-5. These existing requirements apply to personnel auditing activities which are at least as technically complex as radiological monitoring. Accordingly, we recommend that words "qualified in radiochemistry and monitoring techniques" be deleted from this Regulatory Guide.
