Subject: Proposed Amendment to 10 CFR Part 9; "Plain English" Revision of the Freedom of Information Act Rule

With reference to the subject proposal, I am herein submitting my comments to your specific questions.

- Yes, I believe the "general public" will have little trouble understanding the Rule.
- (2) Yes, the rule has outlined the process of a Freedom of Information request in such a manner that there can be little misunderstanding.
- (3) I have no suggested changes to make in the rule as proposed.
- (4) While I believe the proposed rule is much more understandable, I do not think more funds should be allocated for this purpose. This can be accomplished by changing Rules to "Plain English" as they are amended or newly adopted.
- (5) At this time I know of no other Rules that would benefit by a "Plain English" revision.

In closing, I hope that my comments have been beneficial and that the "Plain English" revision is adopted.
