Request for Additional Information

1. Under "Organization," indicate who (by title) is responsible for radiographer certification. Also, indicate if the radiographers are responsible for maintaining test status information.
2. Under "Document Control," indicate (by title) is responsible to insure that all QA functions are conducted in accordance with the latest applicable versions of documents.
3. Under "Handling, Storage and Shipping," provide a statement that shipments will not be made unless all tests, certifications, acceptances, and final inspections are complete.
4. Under "Inspection, Test, and Operating Status," indicate who (by title) is responsible to perform the regulatory required inspections and tests per written procedures and who (by title) is responsible to assure that these functions are performed.
5. Provide a statement that procurement documents will be maintained in accordance with part 6 of the submittal.
6. Under "Audits," provide a statement that each quality-related activity will be audited at least once each year by an auditor (or audit team) having no responsibility in the activity being audited.
