PRESS FACILITIES FOR HARRISBURG SUBCOMMITTEE MEETING, JUNE 6, 7, 1979

On 17, May 1979 about 4:45 P.M. I received a call from Mr. Joseph of the Penn State University. He called to inquire if we would like the special press facilities (phones, telecopiers, etc.) installed for the Presidential (Kemeny) Commission to remain in place through our meeting (ACRS TMI Subcommittee) on June 6 and 7, in the Penn State Auditorium. He pointed out that a considerable saving would be involved if the equipment did not have to be reinstalled two weeks after it was removed.

I told him that aside from a table and a few handouts, we rarely provided any special press facilities for our meetings but I agreed to confirm this and call him back the next morning, after consulting with Public Affairs (J. Fouchard's office).

On May 18 I talked with Frank Ingram of Public Affairs. He felt our meeting would not draw enough attention from the press to warrant our providing any special facilities of the nature described. I called Mr. Joseph's office and advised them that we did not need the special equipment and facilities.
