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These records will be maintained in accordance with written procedures. The records shall be identifiable and retrievable. These records shall be maintained in the reactor control room, and shall be accessible to both the Operations Department and the Radiation Safety Officer.

7. Audits

A yearly audit of the QA Program will be performed, using a written check list. Results of each audit will be retained as part of the quality assurance records, and reported to the NSTF Operating Committee. Audit reports will be evaluated and deficient areas corrected. Those persons performing the audit shall be independent of the Nuclear Science and Technology Facility (NSTF) with no direct or indirect responsibility in the use of the TML casks.

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
