This is in response to your letter of February 13, 1979 transmitting the United Nuclear Corporation Naval Products Division Training and Qualification Plan. We have reviewed your submission and determined that certain changes are required for it to become an acceptable document. Please note that further revision will be required to provide for training in weapons other than handguns should the Upgrade Rule be adopted by the Commission.

Please revise your plan as indicated in the enclosure to this letter and furnish six copies of the revised plan for our approval within 30 days.

We have determined that the enclosure to your letter of February 13, 1979 contains information of a type specified in 10 CFR 2.790(d). Accordingly, it is deemed to be commercial or financial information within the meaning of 10 CFR 9.5(a)(4) and shall be subject to disclosure only in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 9.12.

Comments on Security Guard Training and Qualification Plan

4.7 Documentation

This section should contain an explicit provision to retain for NRC review the initial physical and mental certification, as well as subsequent annual regualification.

9.2 Uualification for PCAS Operator

A determination of what constitutes a satisfactory rating needs to be made in this section.

10.2 Qualification of Security Supervisors - New Hires

Your plan allows personnel to act as security supervisors for up to 90 days before they are tested and found qualified. Such a procedure is unacceptable and must be revised.

11.0 Incumbent UNC Security Shift Supervisor - Training and Qualification

Please establish a distinction between supervisory personnel and guards/ watchmen training and qualification programs in this section.

13.0 Weapons Training and Qualification

This section should contain a statement relative to retention of records of qualification.

14.3 Shotgun - Qualifications

In addition to the day qualification with the 12-gauge shotgun, a commitment should be added to provide night familiarization for those personnel expected to respond with such weapons.

15.0 Equipment

M. Duress Alarms

Please provide a description of the duress code system utilized by your security personnel.

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Editorial Comments

2.0 Management Organization

Correct the spelling of responsible in the fourth to last line on page 1.

3.0 Security Organization

Identify type and quantity of all security equipment supplied by the Guard Contractor.

4.6 Regualification for Section 4.3 and 4.5

Change "annual" as used in Parts A and B to "at least every 12 months."

10.0 Supervisory Training - New Hires

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Revise Part C to read "new hire supervisors will iemonstrate correct usage of security equipment."

11.0 Incumbent UNC Security Shift Supervisor - Training and Qualification

Insert the word "correct" before "usage" in the last sentence of this section.
