Dear Mr. Scarano:

The Utah State Environmental Coordinating Committee has reviewed the final EIS; White Mesa Uranium Project/Energy Fuels Nuclear, Inc., and submits the following comments:

The second paragraph under 4.1.2 operation, reads: "Although operation of the mill facility should not have significant impact on air quality, Utah Air conservation Regulations require that air pollution control equipment and processes be selected and operated to provide the highest efficiencies and lowest discharge rates that are *reasonable and practical*, while the degree of control is subject to approval by the State Air Conservation Committee, the control must be *minimum of 85%*."

The italicized wording is added. The regulations were revised in February, 1979. The revised regulations require use of available control technology.
