page two William A. Nixon publicity basis. We will no longer consider it necessary to deal with your department since your letter denies any responsibility concerning the same. 2. No later than August 1st, 1979 the City of West Chicago will proceed to dig up all of the material that is in the City of West Chicago at various sites and remove it to a public land fill. Since you have denied responsibility for this it seems that in any legal action you will not be able to prevent this action by the City. In the event you wish to file suits against the City of West Chicago to prevent this action you may feel free to do so. I am sure that you will receive a proper defense to this action both legal and otherwise. Under no condition will the City tolerate becoming a licensed agent. We will not release the government nor Kerr-McGee as far as that situation is concerned. I am sorry that we must take this stand with your department as well as Kerr-McGee but you leave us no alternative. It is most difficult for a municipality to deal with the powers represented by a large corporate institution, and an agency of it's government which gives so little cooperation to a fellow governmental unit. Also in view of your new position, any verbal approvals to conduct further testing on public land are hereby terminated.
