Specification 4.2.3.1 of Appendix B to the Trojan Operating License (FOL), NPF-1, outlines procedures to be followed if milk samples cannot be obtained as specified in Table 4-2 of Appendix B. Milk samples are currently required by Table 4-2 to be taken monthly from the Palmer Dairy, listed as Location 17. This dairy is no longer operational and, from all indications, will the resume operations in the foreseeable future. In accordance with Sections 4.2.3.1 and 5.5.3(b) of Appendix B of the Trojan FOL, NPF-1, you are hereby advised that milk samples are no longer being taken from this sampling location.

Although no suitable alternative to this site is currently available, PCE is maintaining a continual awareness of milk-producing animals in the Trojan environs. Should the Palmer Dairy again become operational or should another suitable milk sampling site develop, PGE will initiate a sampling program from these locations as soon as possible. License Change Application 50, submitted to your office on March 15, 1979, corrects this discrepancy in our environmental radiation monitoring program.
