Hartsville Nuclear Plants A and B and Phipps Bend Nuclear Plant

Chicago Bridge & Iron submitted a generic report by letter from W. G. Oehlkers to W. G. Reinmuth dated May 1, 1979, responding to Bulletin 78-12 for reactor pressure vessels fabricated by them.

GE has notified us that the Hartsville and Phipps Bend reactor pressure vessels are covered by this report. TVA is reviewing this report and will provide a final response for Hartsville and Phipps Bend by August 31, 1979.

Yellow Creek Nuclear Plant

CE submitted a generic report by letter from A. E. Scherer to H. D. Thornburg dated June 8, 1979. TVA has not yet received this report. By August 31, 1979, TVA will provide a supplemental report on Yellow Creek.

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
