You had recently expressed interest in the status of activities at the General Electric Company's Vallecitos Nuclear Center under License No. SNM-960 issued by the Commission. The Friends of the Earth and others had requested that the Commission suspend this License and order removal of all plutonium from the Vallecitos site. For the reasons given in the attached Decision, the Director of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards has denied these requests.
