## RESOLUTION

AD 1828.20 needs to list the requirement to perform at least one drill per year on a "Back Shift" for each fire brigade.

Commitment to make procedure changes by October 25, 1979.

AD 1828.20 needs to list the requirement to perform a sufficient number of unannounced drills.

Commitment to make procedure changes by October 25, 1979.

AD 1810.01 needs to provide for additional portable suppression equipment for transient fire loads.

Commitment to make procedure changes by October 25, 1979.

AD 1810.01 needs to list the restrictions prohibiting smoking in safety-related areas.

Commitment to make procedure changes by October 25, 1979.

NOTE: The above resolutions are consistent with the facility license to have the Fire Protection Program completely implemented by the first refueling.

Failure to review and approve fire protection program implementation procedures. (Pre-plans)

Failure to establish, implement and maintain adequate procedures covering fire protection program implementation.

Fire emergency procedure EP1202.35 needs to be changed to guide Control Room personnel to the fire pre-plans in event of fire.

Service water emergency procedure EP1202.19 needs to be changed to include a valve line-up check sheet and return to normal.

All fire brigade members need to be qualified on respiratory training.

AD 1810.00 needs to list the physical examination requirements for each fire brigade member.

AD 1810.00 needs to list the minimum eligibility requirements of a fire protection engineer position.

AD 1828.20 needs to provide for classroom instruction program to be repeated over a two year period.

AD 1828.20 needs to provide for practice sessions under strenuous conditions

Commitment to review and approve all pre-plans distributed by October 25, 1979.

Commitment to make identified procedure changes to administrative controls by October 25, 1979.

Commitment to make procedure changes by July 31, 1979.

Commitment to make procedure changes by July 15, 1979.

Commitment to qualify all fire brigade members by October 25, 1979.
