
Dear Mr. DeLine:

By letter dated October 20, 1978, you submitted a revision of the Security Plan for the Dow TRIGA Facility. As a result of our review we agree with your assessment that the effectiveness of the security plan is not decreased. Since NRC acceptance of your Physical Security Plan should properly be reflected in the license authorization for your facility, we are treating your letter as a request for appropriate Commission authorization. This has been discussed with and agreed to by your staff. In this connection, we are herewith issuing Amendment No. 4 to Facility License No. R-108, which identifies your currently approved security plan.

Future changes which do not decrease the effectiveness of your plan do not require prior NRC approval but should continue to be reported as provided in 10 CFR §50.54(p). Changes which do require prior NRC approval should be identified as license amendment requests.

The documents comprising the currently approved security plan for the Dow TRIGA Facility and our evaluation findings have been placed in the Commission's files. Pursuant to 10 CFR Part 2.790(d), this information is being withheld from public disclosure.
