Dear Mr. Blodget:

This is in response to your letter dated July 23, 1979 in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, copies of all testimony related to the Three Mile Island Nuclear Generating Station Unit 2 incident.

The enclosed report, "Title List-Publicly Available Documents - Three Mile Island Unit 2 - Docket 50-320", identifies those records subject to your request which have been disclosed publicly as of June 30, 1979. These records have been placed in Docket File 50-320 at the NRC Public Document Room (PDR), 1717 H Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20555, where they are available for public inspection and copying. The charge for reproducing these records is eight cents (\$0.08) per page, as specified in 10 CFR 9.14(a) of the Commission's regulations. Copies can be purchased by writing directly to the PDR. Upon agreement to pay the reproduction charges, the PDR will arrange for the records to be reproduced by Potomac Research, Inc., a private reproduction contractor servicing the PDR. You will be billed directly by Potomac Research, Inc. for the reproduction charges, plus tax and postage.
