Dear Dr. Garrity:

This is in reference to your financial assurance submittal dated July 10, 2019, requesting that the Letter of Credit be amended as to the licensee's mailing address. Per an internal self-assessment, it was determined that the Certificate of Financial Assurance dated June 23, 2010, is no longer consistent with your license. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. The mailing address on the amended Letter of Credit is 1918 F Street, NW, Washington, D.C. 20052 while the license has the address as 2121 I Street, NW, Suite 601, Washington, D.C. 20052. Per the telephone conversation between Gregory Smith, your Radiation Safety Officer, and myself on August 28, 2019, we understand that your mailing address is currently unchanged but that it will be changed in the near future. Please confirm that the new mailing address is correct and submit a request to amend the specific license which will be controlled under a separate Mail Control Number.
2. The Certificate of Financial Assurance dated June 23, 2010, contains references to sealed sources no longer referenced on your license as line items. Also, the total possession limit of Special Nuclear Material is listed on the license as 10 microcuries rather than 50 microcuries. Please submit a revised Certificate of Financial Assurance.

In order to continue prompt review of your application, we request that you submit your response to this letter within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter.


