I write on behalf of our client, Bluefield Holdings, LLC ("Seller"). On August 14, 2019, Seller notified the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the "NRC") of a proposed indirect change of control of Bluefield Hospital Company LLC d/b/a Bluefield Regional Medical Center (the "Licensee"), which holds the above-referenced radioactive materials license. The purpose of this letter is to respond to your August 29, 2019, request for additional information (the "Request") regarding the transaction. Please see below for responses to the questions posed in the Request.

1. Please provide a complete, clear description of the transaction, and include a pre- and post-transaction organizational chart showing the corporate structure of the license holder and its parent companies, if any.

Please see <u>Exhibit A</u>. Based on our conversations with a representative of the NRC, the parties understand that the anticipated transaction constitutes an indirect transfer of control.

2. Please describe any changes in the organization, including but not limited to, transfer of stocks or assets and mergers, change in members on Board of Directors, etc. that will occur as a result of the change of control. Please confirm that the licensee name, mailing address, and contact information, including phone numbers will remain the same.

As described above and in Exhibit A, as a result of the transaction, Seller will transfer its 100% of membership interest in the Licensee to Princeton Community Hospital Association, Inc. ("Buyer"). There will be no transfer of assets, nor will there be any change in the Licensee's legal name or federal tax identification or Medicare provider numbers. The Licensee will continue to be the owner and licensed operator of the hospital and associated facilities and equipment, pre- and post-Closing. The Officers will change at the time of Closing in that Jeff Lilley will become BRMC's Chief Executive Officer and Secretary, and Frank Sinicrope will be become its Chief

Financial Officer and Treasurer. PCH may also elect to change some members of the Board of Directors, as well. In the event of such a change, the new Directors will be identified prior to and appointed as of the date of Closing. There will be no change in the Licensee's name, mailing address, or contact information, including (phone numbers).

3. Please describe the status of the licensee's facilities, equipment, and radiation safety program, including any known contamination, at the time of the transfer. Include the status of calibrations, leak tests, area surveys, wipe tests, training, quality control, and related records.

The Licensee's Nuclear Medicine Room is secure and identified as hazardous on the life safety plans. All radioactive sources are sealed and leak tested quarterly by the NPC (National Physics Consultants). The Radiation Safety Program is overseen by the Radiation Safety Officer and meets quarterly. There are no known contaminations. The status of all surveys and tests are up to date and records are kept to reflect last NRC Inspections which was completed in 2018 with no violations.

4. Please confirm that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility will be transferred to the transferee or to NRC, as appropriate. These records include documentation of surveys of ambient radiation levels and fixed and/or removable contamination, including methods and sensitivity.


