SUBJECT: AFFIRMATION SESSION 79-17, 3:05 P.M. MONDAY, MAY 7, 1979,  
COMMISSIONERS' CONFERENCE ROOM, D.C. OFFICE  
(OPEN TO PUBLIC ATTENDANCE)

- I. Proposed Orders to Shut Down Rancho Seco Nuclear Generating Station (Sacramento Municipal Utility District, Docket No. 50-312), and Oconee Nuclear Station, Units 1, 2, and 3 (Duke Power Company, Docket Nos. 50-269, 50-270, and 50-287)

The Commission, by a vote of 5-0, approved the subject orders, which confirm agreements reached between the NRC staff and the respective licensees on actions necessary to provide added reliability to the reactor systems to respond safely to the feedwater transients. The Orders would become effective on issuance for an indefinite period until the actions described in the Order have been satisfactorily completed\*.

\*Although voting in favor of the Orders as written, Commissioner Bradford would have preferred that the texts of the Orders include language requiring a further Commission Order prior to resumption of operation of these facilities.

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
