Attendance)

The Commission was briefed by representatives of the offices of Nuclear Reactor Regulation and Inspection and Enforcement regarding the known sequence of events at Jersey Central Power and Light Company's Oyster Creek Station on May 2, 1979, when a reactor high pressure scram and subsequent instrument indication of a triple low reactor water level occurred. No formal actions were taken during the briefing. The Commission requested it be kept advised of any further developments.

The Chairman indicated to Congressman Maguire, who was in attendance, that NRC would keep the New Jersey Congressional delegation and the Governor informed of developments at Oyster Creek.
