Dear Ms. Hembey:

We wish to express our sincere appreciation for your kind assistance in preparation of this letter with respect to a request for amendment of the subject license, which is still believed to be under the review of United States State Department.

This request for an amendment is to include Borg-Warner Nuclear Valve, Div. of Borg-Warner B. V. 4870 AB Etten-Leur, The Netherlands, as an intermediate consignee. Intermediate end use is to install accessories (i. e. solenoid valves, limit switches, junction boxes) on 154 pieces of air operated valves and perform operability test at the aforementioned facilities prior to reexporting them to the final destination in Belgium, i. e. the site of Tihange II. This undertaking has become necessary in order to avoid delivery delay which could have otherwise taken place since said accessories are of Western European origin and, therefore, must be imported into the United States. Furthermore, our contract with Comprimo Belgie expressly stipulates a very stringent delay penalty clause under which we could be penalized up to ten percent of the contract amount for delivery delay.

We currently have all 154 air actuated valves ready for customer's source inspection at our factory and as soon as they pass the source inspection they will be sent to our facility in the Netherlands. Any delay beyond mid June (1979) may result in the customer invoking the foregoing penalty provision.


