Dear Commissioner Bradford:

The book "We Almost Lost Detroit" and literature being distributed by local anti-nuclear groups claim that the malfunction in October 1966 at the Fermi 1 breeder reactor in Monroe, Michigan created an extremely hazardous condition for many months, with possibility of meltdown.

Does an "insiders" report exist describing without evasion what happened at Fermi 1 in 1966 -- what events occurred; what level of threat existed how long; how precisely could the level of threat be defined then and now; who controlled public information; what public reporting, if any was agreed to, what suppressed, why.

Can you supply me such a report? If not, who may have possession of one?
