I know of no study or report of the type requested in your letter of April 12th. The only report on the FERMI-1 accident that I have seen is a purely technical assessment of the accident and some of the problems involved in the cleanup. It contains none of the information requested in your letter.

I am providing a copy of your letter to the office that handles Freedom of Information Act requests with a suggestion that your letter be treated as such a request.

I would suggest that, to obtain a complete picture, you make a similar request pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act and with as much specificity as possible to the Department of Energy. DOE is heir to many of the Atomic Energy Commission's records.
