## Request for Additional Information

- In part 1, the responsibilities assigned to "packers and shippers" are often assigned to radiographers. Please review that last paragraph of part 1 and clarify that the persons performing the indicated tasks are appropriately trained and certified.
- 2. In part 2, please indicate who (by title) is responsible to assure that all radioactive material shipping packages are designed and manufactured under a QA Program approved by Nuclear Regulatory Commission for all packages designed or fabricated after the effective date of the QA Program. Note that this requirement can be satisfied by receiving a certification to this effect from the manufacturer.
- In part 4, indicate what personnel (by title) perform the critical handling, storage, and shipping operations.
- 4. In part 5, the responsibilities assigned to "shipping personnel" are often assigned to radiographers. Please review the last paragraph of part 5 and clarify that the persons performing the indicated tasks are appropriately trained and certified.

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
