2 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: Are you ready to affirm?

3 Why don't we go ahead and do an affirmation while
4 people are coming and going?

5 Are you ready?

6 Do Affirmation 1, and then I will hold a vote.

7 MR. CHILK: The first one is SECY-A-79-42, NECO
8 Sheffield, Illinois.

9 The purpose of the paper was to obtain Commission
10 approval of a memorandum and an order sustaining the immediate
11 effectiveness of a staff order to show cause on the 10 CFR .202
12 and a notice of hearing.

13 The General Counsel circulated for you a notice of
14 hearing and an order, of which I am advised all of you have
15 read. And I would ask you to affirm your vote.

16 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: Aye.

17 COMMISSIONER AHEARNE: Aye.

18 COMMISSIONER BRADFORD: Aye.

19 COMMISSIONER GILINSKY: Aye.

20 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: So ordered.

21 In order to do the next one, I need to ask you to
22 join me in voting to hold an affirmation on an item which is
23 the approval under Section 145(b) of the Atomic Energy Act
24 for members of the President's Commission on the Accident at
25 Three Mile Island to have access to restricted data and

1 national security information.

2 Those in favor of a short-notice meeting for
3 affirmation purposes vote aye.

4 COMMISSIONER AHEARNE: Aye.

5 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: Aye.

6 COMMISSIONER BRADFORD: Aye.

7 COMMISSIONER GILINSKY: Aye.

8 MR. CHILK: SECY-79-351, and the purpose is to
9 obtain approval for members of the President's Commission to
10 have access to restricted data and national security
11 information.

12 All of you have approved the recommendation in the
13 paper, which was to give them that access. And I would ask
14 you to affirm.

15 COMMISSIONER AHEARNE: Aye.

16 COMMISSIONER GILINSKY: Aye.

17 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: Aye.

18 COMMISSIONER BRADFORD: Aye.

19 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: So ordered.

20 COMMISSIONER BRADFORD: Have they asked fo. any
21 such information?

22 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: No program is to sweep with a
23 broad brim.
