He stated renting would expose the public to the low dosage of 1 millirem.

No one knows how much radioactivity we have already released because measurement instruments failed early in the

My family, my children and my children's children reside within the miller of T. M. I. A large family to which we are related by marriage already has a predisposition to spore. Now T. M. I and further releases can only make matters worse.

N. R. C. has no moral right to subject civilian populations to this kind of nuclear experimentation.

Seal up Three Mile Island. Don't want you mess on us and sure. If you do deliberately create us we will view you as a criminal on a par with the Nazi doctors.
