Subject: GE-NEBG Organizational Changes

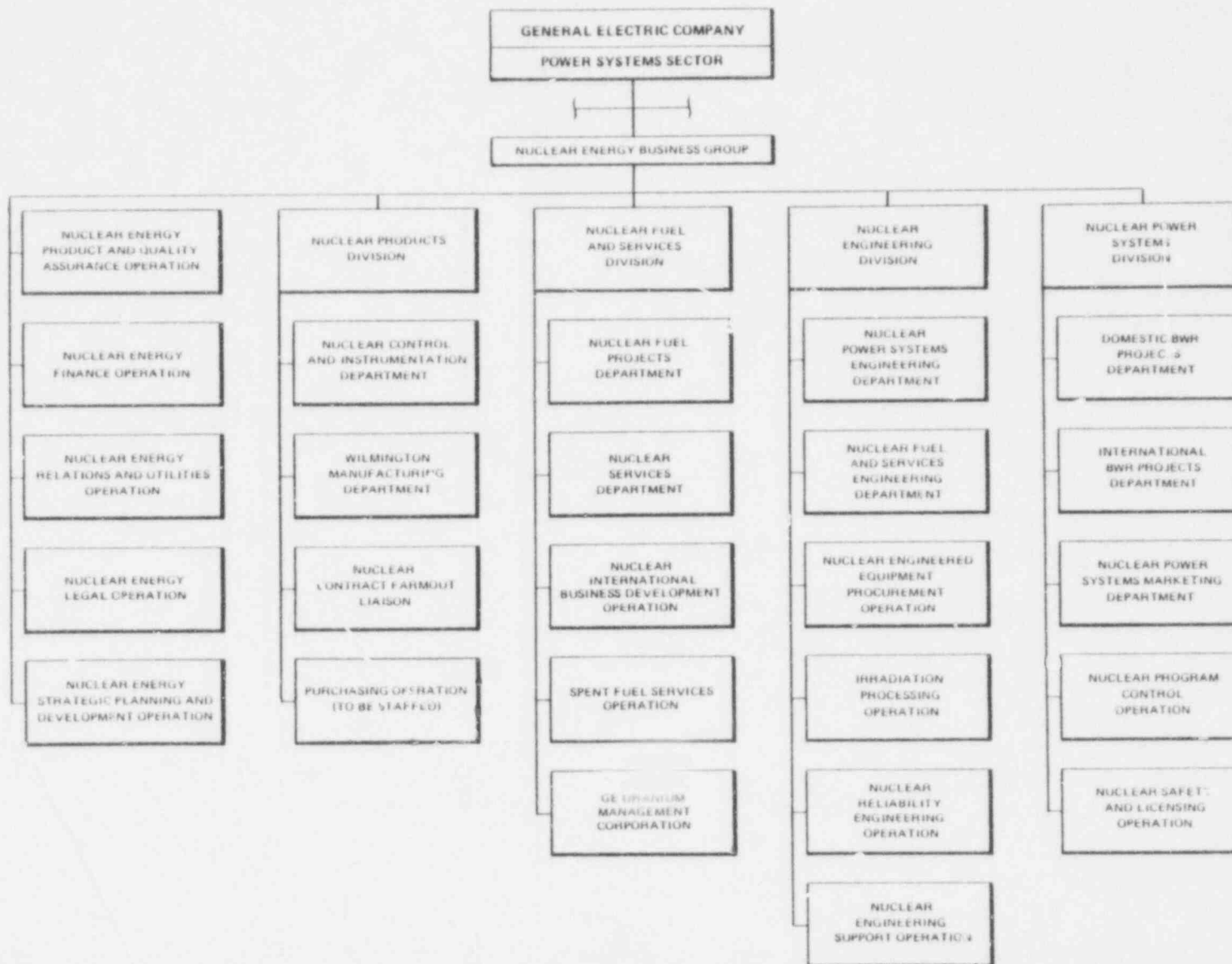


Figure 1-1. Nuclear Energy Business Group 7/1/79

In Licensing Topical Report NEDO-11209-04A, the General Electric Company has committed to notify the NRC of organizational changes affecting the BWR QA Program within thirty days after implementation. In compliance with this commitment, notification of organizational changes effective July 1, 1979, as documented on the attached draft chart, "Figure 1-1 Nuclear Energy Business Group," (page 1-11 of NEDO-11209-04A), is transmitted.

The principal project management organizational changes are reflected in the establishment of two new division-level components: the Nuclear Fuel & Services Division and the Nuclear Power Systems Division. Concurrently, the former Nuclear Energy Programs Division and the Nuclear Energy Projects Division were discontinued. The reorganization places project management responsibility for nuclear fuel-related activities and management responsibility for nuclear services in the new Nuclear Fuel & Services Division. The reorganization places project management responsibility for nuclear steam supply systems in the new Nuclear Power Systems Division.

The principal product design organizational changes are reflected in a realignment of responsibilities within the Nuclear Engineering Division with the establishment of the Nuclear Power Systems Engineering Department and the Nuclear Fuel & Services Engineering Department, and the concurrent discontinuance of the BWR Systems Engineering Department and the Nuclear Technology Department. This reorganization places basic responsibility for nuclear steam supply system design in the new Nuclear Power Systems Engineering Department and for nuclear fuel and services design in the new Nuclear Fuel & Services Engineering Department.

In this reorganization no quality-related functions were discontinued. Other changes below the Department/Operation level are in the process of review and approval and will be transmitted to you as changes to the organizational charts on pages 1-12


