Gentlemen:

This refers to your Site Security Personnel Training Plan transmitted by your letter of February 20, 1979. We have reviewed the plan and find it generally acceptable. However, your submission cannot be accepted until a schedule for qualifying security personnel is provided. Please submit a schedule by July 15, 1979 so that your plan may be approved by July 31, 1979. You should also note that revision to your plan to provide for training with other weapons will be required in the future if the Upgrade Rule is adopted by the Commission.

We have established that the enclosure to your letter of February 20, 1979 contains information of a type specified in 10 CFR 2.790(d). Accordingly, the enclosure is deemed to be commercial or financial information within the meaning of 10 CFR 9.5(a)(4) and shall be subject to disclosure only in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 9.12.

9.0 FACILITY SECURITY

9.1 The licensee shall follow the plans indicated below:

9.1.A The licensee shall follow the security plan entitled, "Physical Protection Plan for the West Jefferson Nuclear Science Area, June 10, 1977," as amended by these license conditions and as further amended pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 70.32(e).

9.1.B (RESERVED - SAFEGUARDS CONTINGENCY PLAN)

9.1.C The licensee shall follow the Site Security Personnel Training Plan, Battelle Columbus Laboratories, dated February 14, 1979 and as amended by these license conditions and as further amended pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 70.32(e).

9.2 No statement in the licensee's facility plans as described in 9.1 above shall relieve the licensee of a requirement of 10 CFR Part 73 unless granted in a specific exemption or exception set forth as a condition of this license.
