Dear Sir:

It has come to my attention that radioactive waste material is being stored at the Naval Air Station at Point Mugu, California. I also understand that the material is in the form of dry waste and is being stored in DOT 17H barrels which are located on a concrete slab next to the old porpoise pools.

Under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act I would like to know the answers to the following questions: 1) Where did this radioactive material come from? 2) What are the contaminants and what are the levels of contamination? 3) Has any of this material been dumped in an area off the coast of Oxnard known as the "Hueneme Canyon"? 4) How is this radioactive material being disposed of? 5) Have Ventura County officials been notified of the presence of this material? 6) What precautions have been taken to protect the public from harms associated with exposure to radioactive material?
