This refers to the special inspection conducted by Mr. C. Rowe of this office on November 3, 1980 of activities authorized by NRC License No. 37-14855-01 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Rowe with Mr. G. Weiss of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The area examined during this inspection was limited to a review of an occurrence on August 18, 1980 which resulted in an exposure of 2700 millirem to a radiographer in your employ. Within this area, the inspection consisted of examination of representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.
