NRC STAFF MOTION REQUESTING LEAVE TO SUBMIT A RESPONSE TO FEMA'S POST-HEARING LETTER AND ADMIT EXHIBIT NRC-020 INTO THE HEARING RECORD

Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.323, the staff of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), hereby requests leave to submit a response to the post-hearing letter from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) that was received by the NRC following the August 14, 2019 hearing in this matter.
