Meeting in the above-entitled matter was convened, pursuant to notice, at 4:10 p.m., JOSEPH M. HENDRIE, Chairman, presiding.

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P R O C E E D I N G S

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2 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: Okay. The Secretary will now
3 lead us in the reading of the affirmations.

4 MR. CHILK: SECY-79-327, in which the Commission
5 approved amendments to 10 CFR 50 and 70 to provide for on-
6 site office space for resident inspectors and immediate
7 facility access to NRC inspection personnel.

8 All of you concurred with that paper and I will
9 ask you to affirm your votes.

10 COMMISSIONER GILINSKY: Aye.

11 COMMISSIONER BRADFORD: Aye.

12 COMMISSIONER KENNEDY: Aye.

13 COMMISSIONER AHEARNE: Aye.

14 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: Aye.

15 So ordered.

16 MR. CHILK: SECY-79-294, which is the reduction of
17 the radiography overexposures in which all of you have agreed
18 that a publication of the proposed amendments to 10 CFR Part
19 34 with modifications would be geared into the proposed
20 amendments and circulated to you on the first of June.

21 And I would ask you to affirm your votes on
22 this item.

23 COMMISSIONER GILINSKY: Aye.

24 COMMISSIONER BRADFORD: Aye.

25 COMMISSIONER KENNEDY: Aye.

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COMMISSIONER AHEARNE: Aye.

CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: Aye.

So ordered.

MR. CHILK: I have taken the Seabrook seismic shutdown out because there has been an agreement amongst you, as I understand it, to modify the proposed order and that will be coming up next week.

The last paper is SECY-78-682, which is a revision of NRC regulation governing ownership of stocks, bonds and other security interests which has just been approved, and so recently, that I am going to ask Trip to lead you through it.

COMMISSIONER GILINSKY: I approved?

(Simultaneous discussion).

CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: Your office outvoted you five one.

MR. CHILK: The Chairman -- I have not had a vote from Mr. Bradford, although I understand --

COMMISSIONER BRADFORD: You have been told that it --

MR. CHILK: -- told that it can be affirmed.

COMMISSIONER BRADFORD: That I was prepared to be outvoted on those areas where that seems likely.

MR. ROTHSCHILD: Can I go through the major points of this paper and then make --

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(Simultaneous discussion)

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2 COMMISSONER KENNEDY: Are we going to sit here and
3 go through this paper?

4 The answer is no, I'm not.

5 I've already been through it four times, and that
6 is enough for me.

7 MR. CHILK: If one Commissioner is not ready to
8 act on it, I think under our rules -- (Inaudible.)

9 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: We better stick strongly to
10 the rules we firmly established, that we don't discuss
11 papers at affirmations.

12 COMMISSIONER KENNEDY: That's right.

13 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: So, you know we will pull it
14 and --

15 MR. CHILK: I take responsibility. I weakened
16 to the argument of General Counsel and tried to let him lead
17 you through it.

18 (Simultaneous discussion and laughter.)

19 COMMISSIONER KENNEDY: We urge that such
20 argument from General Counsel not be entertained in
21 the future, much less given.

22 MR. CHILK: Not from the individual, his office.

23 MR. BICKWIT: It doesn't sound very good to me.

24 (Laughter.)

25 COMMISSIONER BRADFORD: As I understood it, though,

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1 there was some good reason for its speediness, having to
2 do with statements that had to be filed before July 1.
3 Somaybe it would be better to schedule it for an early date.

4 COMMISSIONER GILINSKY: Fine with me.

5 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: That's right. Yes, you better
6 take a look so it can go right back on.

7 COMMISSIONER KENNEDY: Commissioners who have
8 not had the opportunity to do so, might try to focus on
9 it before we get to the table the next time.

10 COMMISSIONER GILINSKY: I will take that kindly.

11 (Laughter.)

12 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: Okay.
