to whom it may concern:

Under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 552, I am requesting access to any transcripts or records that described possible dumping grounds for Nuclear wastes in the Countys of TRUMBULL and WYONING located in Ohio. I would like to know what the locations are and why they were chosen.

I am requesting this information because there have been many unconfirmed reports that some townships in these two Countys were being considered for possible dumping sites for Nuclear wastes by the Federal government.

As you know, the act permits you to reduce or waive fees when the release of the information is considered as "primarily benefiting the public". I believe that this request fits that catagory and I therefore ask that you waive any fees.

If all or any part of this request is denied, please cite the specific exemptions which you think justifies your refusal to release the information, and inform me of the appeal procedures available to me under law.

I would appreciate your handling this request as quickly as possible and I look forward to hearing from you within 10 days, as the law stipulates.
