Dear Mr. Grimsley:

Within the past few years an NRC license has been issued to various companies pursuant to 10 CFR, Section 32.22 to manufacture, process, produce, import or transfer self-luminous products containing tritium. The specific license pertain to liquid crystal display watches in which the liquid crystal is lighted by glass tubes coated with a phosphor and containing gaseous hydrogen. The gaseous hydrogen is the hydrogen isotope with an atomic mass of 3.

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act I request the entire package of material which led to issuance of a license to Texas Instruments and also the entire packet which led to the issuance of a license to Timex Corporation.
