This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. D. L. Kelley of this office during the period April 30 - May 3, and May 5-10, 1979, of activities authorized by NRC Operating License DPR-40, and to his discussion of the findings with members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Principal area examined during the inspection was the follow-up on the licensee's response to IE Bulletin 79-06B.
