SUBJECT: STAFF VIEWS OF TECHNICAL AREAS OF CONCERN TO BE CONTAINED
 IN COMMISSION'S FURTHER ORDER IN THE THREE MILE ISLAND
 UNIT 1 SUSPENSION

On July 2, 1979, the Commission ordered that the Three Mile Island Unit 1 reactor remain in cold shutdown condition until further order of the Commission itself. The Order also provided that the Commission would issue a further order within thirty days specifying in detail the bases for its concerns, and the procedures to govern the hearing which the Commission directed be held prior to restart of the facility. NRR was asked to provide a listing of the areas of technical concern to be resolved in connection with any restart of Three Mile Island Unit 1.

The Office of the Executive Legal Director has already provided the Commission with a draft of the procedural portions of the Commission's further order. We have retyped that draft (except for Section IV which is purely procedural), inserting what we believe to be the appropriate technical content. The integrated draft is attached. We are prepared to discuss it with the Commission at your convenience.
