Attached please find a copy of the final ISI Report for the Spring 1979 Inservice Inspection of the Reactor Pressure Vessel and Primary System Piping for the Dresden Nuclear Power Station, Unit 2, Illinois State Number 82800, located in Morris, Illinois. The station is owned and operated by Commonwealth Edison Company, whose address is 72 West Adams Street, Chicago, Illinois.

The Unit's commercial service date is June 9, 1972, and its gross generating capacity is 834 MWe. The reactor pressure vessel was manufactured by Babcock and Wilcox Company, and the prime contractor for the primary system piping was General Electric Company.

The Inservice Inspection was performed from March 20, 1979 to April 25, 1979.

The Authorized Code Inspector was Mr. B. Caldwell from Hartford Steam Boiler Inspection and Insurance Company of Hartford, Connecticut, whose address is Suite 416, 120 South Riverside Plaza, Chicago, Illinois, 60606.

The inspections performed, conditions observed, and corrective measures recommended and taken are contained in the attached report.
