Gentlemen:

Pursuant to 5 U.S.C. Section 552 and 10 C.F.R. Section 9.8, this is a Freedom of Information Act request for certain records and files pertaining to the above cases.

In early June, Commonwealth Edison Co. announced that the construction and completion of its facilities at LaSalle County would be delayed for about nine months. According to press releases and telephone conversations our organization has had with Steve Goldman of Commonwealth Edison and Jan Strasma, press officer for the NRC Region III office in Glen Ellyn, Illinois, structural alterations were to be undertaken during this period. These alterations consist of installing metal braces on the downcomers piping system, according to Messrs. Strasma and Goldman. Citizens Against Nuclear Power is concerned of the possibility that additional structural change measures are being contemplated by Commonwealth Edison Co. We therefore request copies of all documents in the possession of the Commission bearing upon or relating to the delay in construction and completion of the LaSalle County facilities and the planned and/or prospective conduct to be undertaken by Commonwealth Edison Co. during this period of time. This should include, but not be limited to, recorded minutes, memoranda, reports and all other documents pertaining to design and construction modifications and alterations now underway or intended to be implemented in the future.
