Gentlemen:

We have reviewed Revision I to your Safeguards Contingency Plan submitted with your letter of May 18, 1979 and have determined that your revised plan is acceptable.

In view of the fact that the Physical Security Plan, Safeguards Contingency Plan and Guard Training and Qualification Plan comprise the essential elements of the physical protection program requirements, we have found it appropriate to incorporate, by reference, all of these plans into your license in the Materials and Plant Protection Amendment to your license. We are revising Conditions 9.0 and 9.1, establishin; 9.1.A to incorporate the physical security plan, 9.1.B to incorporate the physical security plan, 9.1.B to incorporate the Guard Training and Qualification Plan. We are also modifying Condition 9.2 by referring to all of the foregoing plans.

Therefore, in accordance with the foregoing, we are hereby amending Section 9.0 of Materials and Plant Protection Amendment MPP-1 to your License No. SNM-368 by amending License Conditions 9.1 and 9.2 as set forth in the enclosure to this letter, effective 30 days following the receipt of this letter.

We have determined that the enclosure to your letter of May 18, 1979 contains information of a type specified in 10 CFR 2.790(d). Accordingly, it is deemed to be commercial or financial information within the meaning of 10 CFR 9.5(a)(4) and shall be subject to disclosure only in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 9.12.

	No statement in the licensee's facility plans as described in 9.1 above shall relieve the licensee of a requirement of 10 CFR Part 73 unless granted in a specific exemption or exception set forth as a condition of this license.
