Subject: Review of Appendices G and H TO CFR 50

Generally the changes are quite acceptable. They let the codes (ASME III or XI) or standards pick up much of the work and they handle by reference.

With regard to specifics:

I A for steels > 50 ksi cites ASME III G-2110. This is okay; however, I do not forsee the use of higher strength alloys soon so it is academic.

I F Picked up by ASME III - OK. F a good change. Historically, 30 ft-1b has been used to benchmark Charpy tests more than 50 ft-1b.

II G - A better definition.
Deletions OK. Picked up in codes.

III A - Language is clearer. Nothing is lost.

III B 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 - All in ASME III

III C - Now in Appendix H.

IV A (old IV B) - Adds end-of-life 50 ft-lb. A good change. It removes the unresolved issue of failure from ductile shear from consideration.

IV A-2 - Picks up old A 2b and some of A 2d - OK.

IV A-3 - A major change. You may wish to ask the technical bases for ΔT values of 40°F and 60°F.
