NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF AMENDMENT TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE

The U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has issued

Amendment No. 18 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-7, issued to Pacific

Gas and Electric Company (the licensee), which revised Technical Specifications

for operation of the Humboldt Bay Power Plant, Unit No. 3 (the facility)

located near Eureka, California. The amendment is effective as of the date

of its issuance.

The amendment revises the Technical Specifications to extend on a one-time basis the interval for containment integrated leak rate testing until immediately prior to returning the facility to power operation. The amendment also includes the following administrative changes to the Technical Specifications:

- 1. Expression of an allowable tolerance for performing surveillance intervals,
- 2. Addition of a member to the Plant Staff Review Committee,
- 3. Correction of a typographical error, and
- Clarification of General Office Nuclear Power Plant Review and Audit Committee responsibilities.

The application for the amendment complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's rules and regulations. The Commission has made appropriate findings as required by the Act and the Commission's rules and regulations in 10 CFR Chapter ', which are set forth in the license amendment. Prior public notice of this and amendment was not required since the amendment does not involve a significant hazards consideration.

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The Commission has determined that the issuance of this amendment will not result in any significant environmental impact and that pursuant to 10 CFR Section 51.5(d)(4) an environmental impact statement, or negative declaration and environmental impact appraisal need not be prepared in connection with issuance of this amendment.
