Gentlemen:

We have completed our review of your revised Security Guard Training and Qualification Plan which was transmitted to us by your letters of June 15, 1979 (#696-1066) and June 18, 1979 (#696-1067), and further supplemented by your letter of June 26, 1979 (#696-1072). We find the revised plan acceptable.

In view of the fact that the Physical Security Plan, the Safeguards Contingency Plan and the Security Guard Training and Qualification Plan comprise the essential elements of the physical protection program, we have found it appropriate to incorporate, by reference, all of these plans into your license. We are therefore revising License Conditions 9.0 and 9.1, establishing 9.1.A to incorporate the Physical Security Plan, 9.1.B to incorporate the Safeguards Contingency Plan and 9.1.C to incorporate the Guard Training and Qualification Plan. We are also modifying Condition 9.2 to refer to all of the foregoing plans.

Therefore, in accordance with the foregoing, we are hereby amending Section 9.0 of Materials and Plant Protection Amendment MPP-1 to your License No. SNM-696 by amending License Conditions 9.1 and 9.2 as set forth in the enclosure to this letter, effective 60 days after receipt.

We have determined that the enclosure to your letters of June 15, 1979 and June 18, 1979 and your letter of June 26, 1979 contain information of a type specified in 10 CFR 2.790(d). Accordingly, they are deemed to be commercial or financial information within the meaning of 10 CFR 9.5(a)(4) and shall be subject to disclosure only in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 9.12.

- 9.1 The licensee shall follow the plans indicated below.
- 9.1.A The licensee shall follow the security plan number GA-A13075 entitled, "General Atomic Company Physical Security Plan for the Protection of Special Nuclear Material and Vital Equipment Under AEC Licenses," dated October 1974, with page revisions dated January 22, 1975; February 14, 1975; August 16, 1975; January 19, 1976; April 28, 1976; July 9, 1976; May 19, 1977 and September 1, 1977; except as modified by these license conditions and further amended pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 70.32(e).
- 9.1.B (Reserved for Safeguards Contingency Plan.)
- 9.1.C The licensee shall follow the plan entitled, "Security Guard Training and Qualification Plan for General Atomic Company," dated February 1979 as revised on June 15, 1979, June 18, 1979, and by the enclosure to the licensee's letter of June 26, 1979 (#696-1072) and as further amended pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 70.32(e).
- 9.2 No statement in the licensee's plans as described in 9.1 above shall relieve the licensee of any requirement of 10 CFR Part 73 unless granted in a specific exemption or exception set forth as a condition to this license.

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
