I. PAGE 5, SECTION 1.2.1.1 A MINIMUM QUALIFICATION

Changes have been incorporated as suggested.

II. PAGE 6, SECTION 1.3.1.4 MENTAL QUALIFICATION

Additions have been incorporated as suggested.

III. PAGE 7, SECTION 1.3.1.5 PHYSICAL QUALIFICATIONS

Paragraph D was added to address incapacitating diseases and illness recovery as suggested.

Drug/alcohol addiction is adequately addressed in Paragraph A of 1.3.1.5.

IV. PAGE 8, SECTION 1.3.1.6 PHYSICAL FITNESS TESTING

Paragraph B of this section has been revised to clarify the program for the determination of whether a security officer is physically fit to perform routine and contingency duties at VNC.

V. PAGE 8, SECTION 1.3.1.7 PHYSICAL REQUALIFICATION

Additions have been incorporated as suggested.

VI. PAGE 8, SECTION 1.3.2 QUALIFICATION DOCUMENTATION
