This refers to your letter dated April 3, 1979, in response to our letter dated March 20, 1979.

Thank you for informing us of the corrective and preventive actions you documented in response to our correspondence. However, your letter has been reviewed and additional information is found to be needed.

- 1. In response to item B, you failed to assure that the corrective action taken will limit exposure to the individual continuously present to a dose equal to or less than 100 millirem in any seven consecutive days.
- Also you failed to respond to our understandings which are documented in the fourth paragraph on page two of our letter, concerning periodic audits of every authorized user.

Please respond to this office within seven (7) days of receipt of this letter a written statement containing the requested information.
