Subj: FBI Contacts Re TMI

Per your request, the following is a summary of X00S contacts with the FBI since the beginning of the TMI incident

3/28 (Wed.) - S/A contacted by Bill Ward and advised of general situation at TMI. S/A was told that NRC would keep them advised if any information developed which might be of interest to the FBI.

4/2 (Mon.) - Washington Post reported that FBI was looking into possibility of sabotage. Bill Ward spoke to S/A and was told that FBI was not conducting any such investigation and that NRC would be advised if and when such an investigation was opened.

5 (Thurs) Pete Baci spoke to S/A at FBI HQS. S/A Inquired as to whether any further info had been developed on possibility of sabotage. Mr. advised that Bureau had checked out two reports and found them to be without substance and would report findings to DOJ.

4/6 (Fri) - Copy of FBI TWX received at NRC
Ops Center. Dudley Thompson voiced
concern over technical inaccuracies
and offered to provide correct info to
Bureau. Bill Ward relayed this to
Mr.

Later that day, Pete Bacri spoke to Mr.
and explained that FBI TWX
referred to was dated 3/31. Again
repeated NRC offer. Mr.
advised that a representative of
the Phila. Field Office was going to
the site to talk to Mr. Denton and
try to ~~the~~ resolve the question of
sabotage.*

* Note. Neither Ward nor Bacri related
or implied to FBI that sabotage was
suspected. S/A also advised
that Bureau had no reason, at that
time, to suspect sabotage.

4/7 Ops Center advised that FBI rep had
visited site as mentioned above.
