Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by R. F. Rogers, III of this office on April 7 - May 11, 1979, of activities authorized by NRC License Nos. DPR-57 and NPF-5 for the Plant Hatch facility, and to the discussion of our findings held with M. Manry at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection and our findings are discussed in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

We have examined actions you have taken with regard to previously identified enforcement matters. These are identified in the enclosed inspection report.

During the inspection it was found that certain activities under your license appear to be in noncompliance with NRC requirements. These iter and references to pertinent requirements are listed in the Notices of Violation Caclosed herewith as Appendix A. This notice is sent to you pursuant to the provisions of Section 2.201 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Section 2.201 requires you to submit to this office, within 20 days of your receipt of this notice, a written statement or explanation in reply including: (1) corrective steps which have been taken by you, and the results achieved; (2) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further noncompliance; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Details of activities involving safeguards and security measures are exempt from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(d). Therefore, the response to Appendix A requested above should be incorporated in a separate paper and referenced in your reply.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice", Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter with the exception of Appendix A and the enclosed inspection report with the exception of Details II will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room. If this report contains any information other than that in Details II that you (or your contractor) believe to be proprietary, it is necessary that you make a written application within 20 days to this office to withhold such information from public disclosure. Any such application must include a full statement of the reasons on the basis of which it is claimed that the information is proprietary, and should be prepared so that proprietary information identified in the application is contained
